## 2011 Summer Trips

### Open Door Haiti (High School)

**August 3-10**

Haiti is the poorest country in the western hemisphere... and one of our neighbors. Christ called us to love our neighbors, serve the poor, and reach the lost. In August, The Edge will be flying to Cap Haitian, Haiti, to work alongside Open Door Haiti, a church which God is already using to do some great things in Haiti. (They have a school, food ministry, and youth ministry training program, and are working on building an orphanage and widows' village.) Through a combination of relational ministry and work projects, we'll serve this ministry and leave with a bigger understanding of what God is doing in a country very different from our own. **Cost: \$1500, which includes all ministry expenses.**



### Mission: Chicago (Middle School)

You can experience real cross-cultural ministry (and real poverty) right in our own country, too... and in 2011 The Edge will be bringing middle schoolers to Chicago to serve alongside an urban church who is actively reaching their community. You'll learn a lot about missions, justice issues, and our call as Christians in this world... and we bet you'll leave excited about the opportunities we have to make a difference! **Cost: approx. \$175, including ministry expenses. Details TBA in early 2011.**

### A Note About Money

We know paying for trips (especially our big summer ones) can be tough... and we promise to help out in any way we can! The Edge offers partial scholarships for Rockin' Fall Weekend, Districts, and Mission: Chicago. We never want money to keep you away! We will also be offering fundraising opportunities throughout the year, like our annual student auction, where you'll have the opportunity to earn some money for your student account.
